- Secure a copy of Application for Employers Identification Number (Form SS-4) From the IRS
- If a business is to operate under an Sole Proprietor, Assumed Named Certificate should be filed with the Van Zandt County Clerk's office.
- For information pertaining to corporate certificates and Certificate of Formation contact the Secretary of the State.
- For information concerning Sales Tax please contact the State Comptroller's office.
- For information on permits or licenses contact the State Economic Development Office.
- For information pertaining to alcohol sales should contact TABC.
- For Businesses involved in the handling, processing, or packaging of foods contact the Health Department.
- For information on any employee issues you should contact the US Department of Labor or the Texas Workforce Commission.
- For Information about small business programs contact the Small Business Development Center.

- Free design assistance from preservation architects at the Texas Historical commission.
